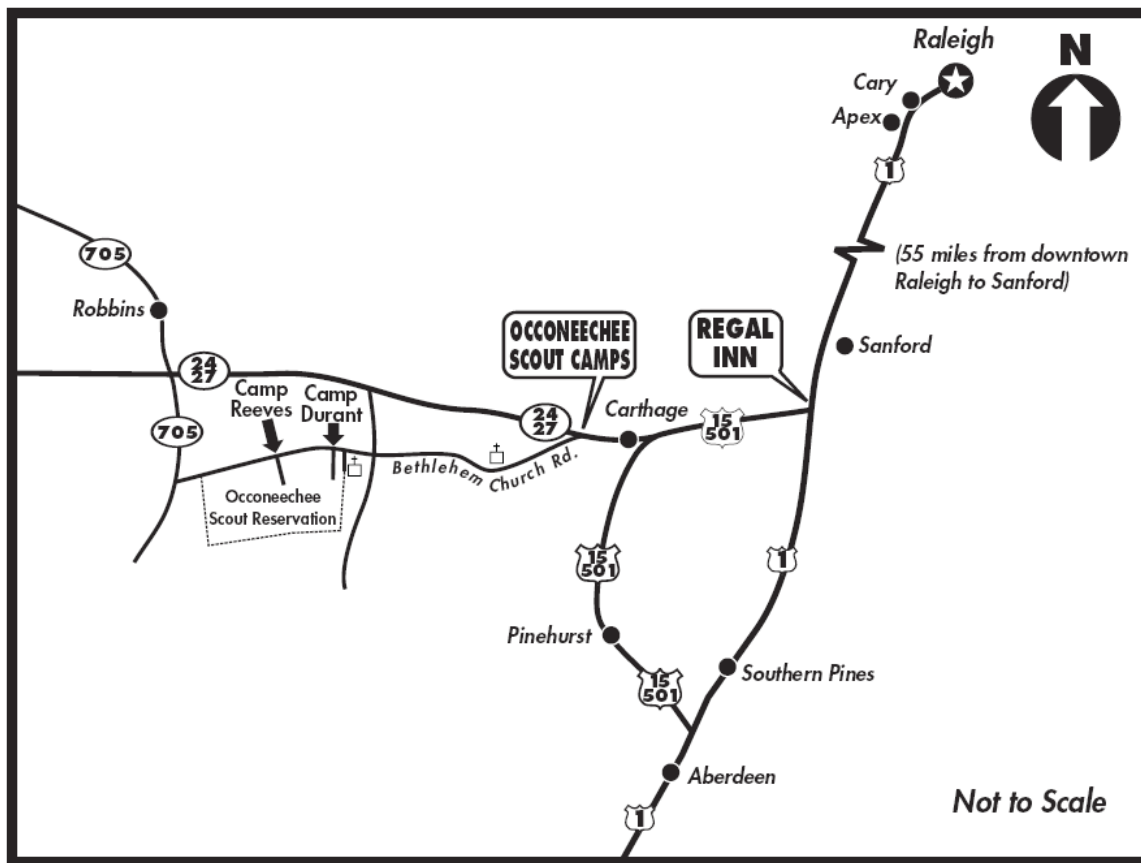


MAP TO OCCONEECHEE COUNCIL CAMPS



Take 15/501 North towards Carthage. Take 24/27 into Carthage. Continue into town until you reach a traffic circle which goes around the town's courthouse. Enter the circle and go halfway around the traffic circle and continue on NC-24/27 to the outskirts of town. After you have passed a couple of convenience markets and a graveyard on your right, you will come to a "Y" intersection where you will turn left onto Bethlehem Church Rd (approximately 1 mile from the courthouse). (On your right will be a green highway information sign with "Occoneechee Scout Camps" and an arrow pointing the way). What used to be an old gas station will be on your left in the middle of the "Y". You will come to a very sharp curve almost immediately after turning ... go slow! After about 8 miles of twisting country road, you will come to a stop sign. After stopping, go through the intersection for less than a mile. On your left you will pass a brick church before coming to the service entrance to Camp Durant. The entrance to Durant is about a half-mile further on the left. Camp Durant phone: (910) 948-2382; FAX (910) 948-2284. The Ranger's residence is about a mile-and-a-half further down Bethlehem Church Rd. on the left at the entrance to Camp Reeves. Alternate directions to entrance of Camp Durant (not depicted on map):

From the roundabout near Moore County Hospital, take 211 to the west past the hospital. Turn right at the first signal past Olmstead Village through Taylor Town (road known alternately as Main Street or Route 1210). Stay on that road for approximately 12 miles until you get to a flashing warning signal (intersection of Route 1210 and Bethlehem Church Road/Route 1261). Turn left at that signal. Camp Durant is about half a mile on the left.
